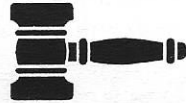

HE OBTAINED AN ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE DEGREE AS A PHOTO TECHNICIAN AND RAN HIS OWN PHOTO LAB FOR THREE YEARS. HE WORKED FOR FOUR YEARS AT EATON KENWAY AND IN 1982 MOVED TO CACHE VALLEY TO TAKE A JOB AT BOURNS. HE HELPED MOVE THE RIVERSIDE NETWORKS DIVISION FROM CALIFORNIA TO HERE. HE TOOK HIS CURRENT JOB A YEAR LATER AS A MANUFACTURING ENGINEER AT CAMPBELL SCIENTIFIC.

IN THE EARLY 90'S, DON WAS THE B.A.R.C. VICE-PRESIDENT AND THEN PRESIDENT. HE SERVED AS A BOARD MEMBER FOR FOR SEVERAL YEARS AS WELL AS THE TRAINING CO-ORDINATOR. HE ALSO SERVED AS VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE WIMU '92 COMMITTEE (WYOMING, IDAHO, MONTANA, UTAH). HE SAYS IT WAS A GREAT EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH KATHY RUDNICKI

AND HER HUSBAND JIM. DON ALSO WORKED ON THE UTAH HAMFEST COMMITTEE IN 1993 AND 1994. AFTER BEING SO HEAVILY INVOLVED FOR SEVERAL YEARS, DON NEEDED TO STEP BACK, TAKE A BREATH, AND GET RE-AQUAINTED WITH HIS FAMILY. DON IS CURRENTLY SERVING AS A B.A.R.C. BOARD MEMBER.

DON HAS SEVERAL HOBBIES IN ADDITION TO HIS RADIO ACTIVITIES LIKE WOODWORKING, MODEL RAILROADING, PHOTOGRAPHY, CAMPING, HIKING, CANOEING, AND BEING IN THE GREAT OUTDOORS.

DON HAS SOME INTERESTING HAM RADIO STORIES. ONE STORY THAT HE LIKES TO SHARE HAPPENED TO HIM MANY YEARS AGO, BACK IN THE 70'S. HE WORKED THE HF BAND, 20 & 40 METERS, DURING THE YEARS WHEN THE SUNSPOTS WERE SO FAVORABLE. ONE DAY HE CONTACTED A "CHET" IN TENNESSEE. HE NOTED THE HAM'S CALL SIGN AND DURING THE VISIT ASKED HIM WHAT KIND OF WORK HE WAS IN. CHET JUST SAID THAT HE WAS IN THE MUSIC BUSINESS LIKE MOST PEOPLE IN TENNESSEE. YEARS LATER, DON NOTICED A PICTURE OF CHET ATKINS ON THE COVER OF A RADIO MAGAZINE. IT GAVE CHET'S CALL SIGN AND DON FELT SURE HE RECOGNIZED IT. HE CHECKED HIS LOGBOOK AND SURE ENOUGH, AFTER ALL THOSE YEARS, HE REALIZED THAT HE HAD VISITED WITH CHET ATKINS. HE HAS HAD CONTACT WITH OTHER CELEBRITIES AS WELL LIKE BARRY GOLDWATER AND RONNIE MILSAP.

ALL FORMAL MESSAGES CONSIST OF 4 PARTS:

- 1) PREAMBLE
- 2) ADDRESS
- 3) TEXT
- 4) SIGNATURE

EACH OF THE ELEMENTS OF THE FORMAL MESSAGE HAS A CERTAIN FORMAT REQUIREMENT WHICH MUST BE MET IN ORDER TO AVOID CONFUSION ON THE AIR AS THE MESSAGE IS SENT, AND ALSO TO ASSURE THAT A SENDER-TO-RECEIVER TRACE CAN ALWAYS BE DONE ON THE MESSAGE.

1) PREAMBLE: THIS PART OF THE MESSAGE IS THE RECORD-KEEPING PART. IT IS READ ON THE AIR FIRST, FROM LEFT TO RIGHT AND ALWAYS IN THIS ORDER. ONLY THE HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS AND TIME OF FILE BLOCKS ARE OPTIONAL AND MAY, IF NOT NEEDED, BE ELIMINATED BY THE ORIGINATING STATION ONLY.

2) ADDRESS: THIS PART OF THE MESSAGE IS INFORMATION ABOUT THE PARTY TO WHOM THE MESSAGE IS BEING SENT. THE ADDRESS CONSISTS OF THE STANDARD THREE-LINE POSTAL ADDRESS, WITH ZIP CODE, AND A FOURTH LINE LISTING THE COMPLETE PHONE NUMBER. THE ZIP CODE IS IMPORTANT IF THE MESSAGE WILL GO VIA PACKET AT ANY POINT. A COMPLETE PHONE NUMBER WILL SAVE THE DELIVERING STATION TIME AND EFFORT.

3) TEXT: THE TEXT IS WHAT THE SENDER OF THE MESSAGE WANTS TO TELL THE ADDRESSEE. GOOD AMATEUR RADIO TEXTS SOUND LIKE TELEGRAPH MESSAGES AND ARE CLEAR AND SUCCINCT. THEY ARE WRITTEN IN SUCH A WAY THAT THEIR MEANING CANNOT BE MISCONSTRUED OR INTERPRETED IN MORE THAN ONE WAY. GOOD AMATEUR MESSAGE WRITING TAKES PRACTICE.

4) SIGNATURE: THE SIGNATURE IDENTIFIES THE PERSON THAT IS SENDING THE MESSAGE. IT COULD BE A THIRD-PARTY SIGNATURE OR THAT OF THE STATION OF ORIGIN ITSELF. THE SIGNATURE SHOULD BE COMPLETE ENOUGH FOR THE ADDRESSEE TO UNDERSTAND WHO IS SENDING THE MESSAGE. FOR MORE OFFICIAL TRAFFIC OR FOR MARS MESSAGES, ADDITIONAL IDENTIFYING DATA MAY BE PLACED IN THE SIGNATURE. AVOID CUTESY-PIE SIGNATURES!

THIS MONTH'S TRAINING TOPIC

RADIOGRAM

A RADIOGRAM IS REFERRED TO AS A FORMAL MESSAGE. FORMAL MEANS THAT THE MESSAGE FOLLOWS A PRE-ESTABLISHED FORM OR CONVENTION. A FORMAL MESSAGE CONTAINS ALL THE NECESSARY "RECORDKEEPING" ELEMENTS THAT ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP A HISTORY OF THE MESSAGE AS IT IS SENT THROUGH THE NATIONAL TRAFFIC SYSTEM (NTS), AND DURING A DECLARED COMMUNICATIONS EMERGENCY IN CACHE VALLEY.

TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THE RADIOGRAM AND FOR PRACTICE ON PASSING FORMAL TRAFFIC PLEASE JOIN THE CACHE VALLEY EMERGENCY AMATEUR RADIO NET (CVEARN) AT 9:00 PM ON THE 146.72 REPEATER EACH SUNDAY NIGHT. 73's Y'ALL. KC7CVI

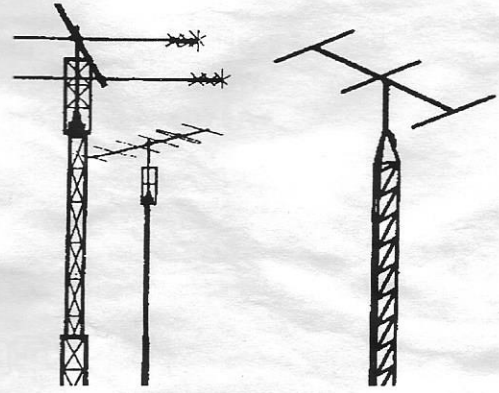
