## Join or Renew

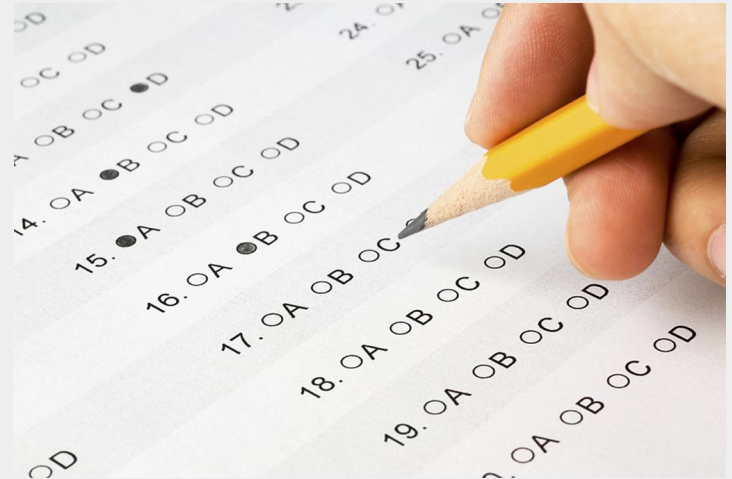

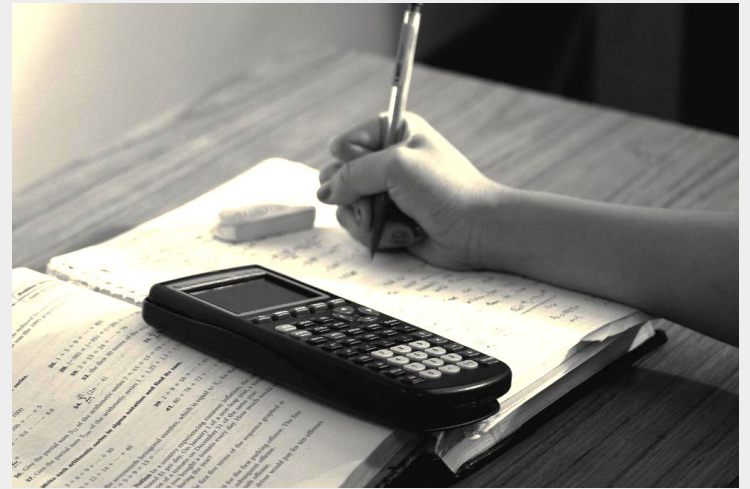
