Join or Renew

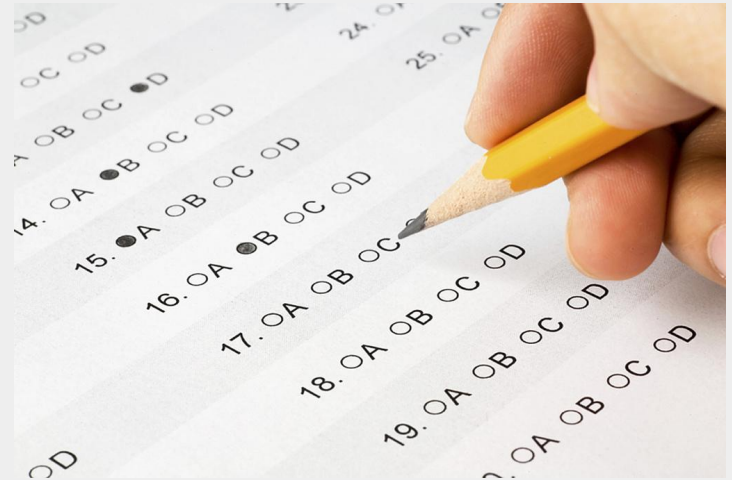

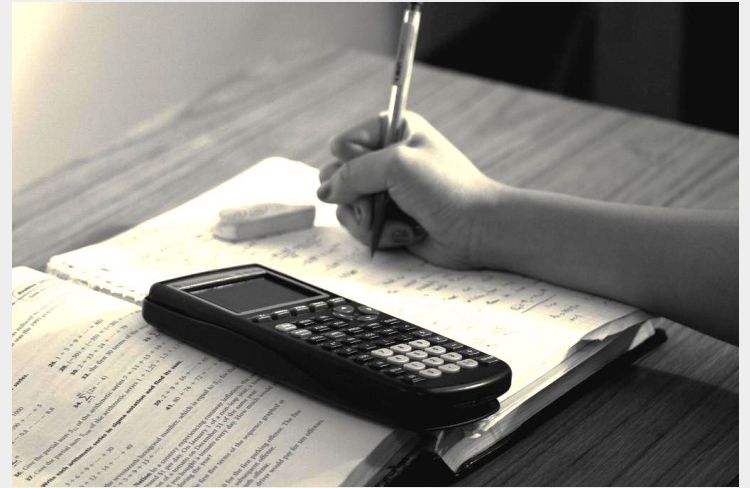




Upcoming “One Day” General Class

Sign Up for 2018 BARC Activities

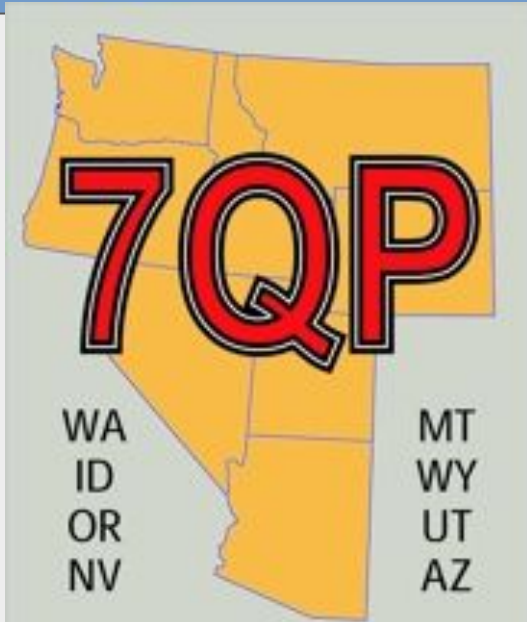

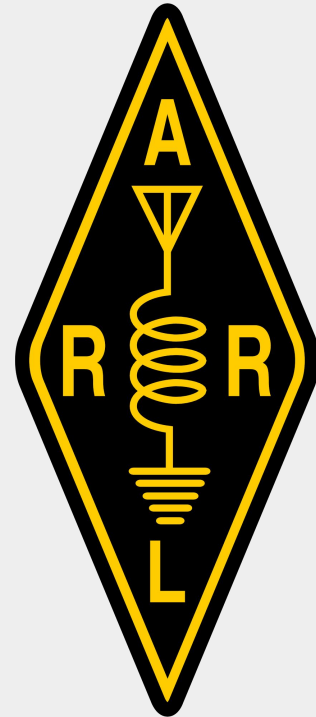


Are you an ARRL Member
